

## AT HOME ACTIVITIES

### **Sensory**

beans, rice, kinetic sand, cornstarch with water, water table w/funnels and measuring cups, make playdough (can be sticky play outside), shaving crème (cleans surfaces as well)

### **Playdough recipe**

3 C flour

1 1/2 C salt

3 C water

6tsp cream of tarter (helps with elasticity)

2 Tbsp oil

Pour all ingredients into a large pot. Stir constantly over medium heat until a dough ball forms by pulling away from the sides. Knead dough until the texture matches play dough (1-2 minutes). Store in plastic container (after cooling). Should last for at least 3 months

### **Puffy play time**

1 C Shave crème (shake)

2-3 Tbsp Glue

stir in glue and will begin to puff up and adheres to paper/card stock/cardboard

mix together. Spread on thick surface (contruction paper picture of polar bear, snow seal, cat. Stick items in the mixture. When it dries it puffs up.

### **Scavenger Hunt**

Outside-green leaf, gray rock, brown stick, purple flower, black dirt, yellow leaf, red flower etc.

Inside-spoon, brush, cotton ball, square of TP, bar of soap, crayon, sticky note...

-paper clip (she loves these have her make a paper clip necklace)

#### **Bubbles**

**Paper plate scissor cutting**-draw lines on plate to cut into triangles or rectangles

**Macaroni stringing**-color using food coloring & rubbing alcohol in Ziploc bag

\*\*\*\*take this opportunity to learn primary colors: *red, yellow, blue.*

Allow mixing to create secondary colors: *green (Y/B), orange (Y/R), purple (R/B)*
